

Environmental Policy



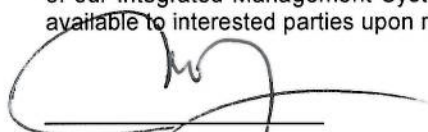
West African Ventures (WAV) recognizes the growing international commitment to environmental management and sustainability principles. WAV acknowledges the potential environmental impact of its operations on the marine, coastal and onshore environments in which it works. WAV activities include Marine offshore support, and Engineering, Procurement, Installation and Commissioning (EPIC) contracts for oil and gas companies in West Africa.

Top Management, in co-ordination with the Environment Management Representative, is accountable for the effectiveness of the Environmental Management System (EMS) and is responsible for ensuring that it is communicated, understood, implemented and maintained at all levels within the company, and ultimately achieves its intended outcome / goal of zero environmental incidents. This policy provides the framework for setting, reviewing and communicating WAV's environmental objectives.

Top Management is committed to ensuring that the Company will:

- Integrate its environmental policies and procedures fully into all business activities as a critical element
- Comply with all applicable environmental legislation, codes, standards and contract requirements, and fulfil its other environmental compliance obligations
- Protect the environment, including preventing pollution to air, sea and land, with particular attention to preventing spills and marine pollution from its offshore and marine support operations
- Make sustainable use of natural resources, including energy, fuel and water, and minimize waste to landfill by reducing waste generation and segregating and recycling waste where economically and operationally feasible
- Reduce greenhouse gas emissions from its operations and vessels where practicable, and build resilience to the effects of a changing climate on its business and host communities
- Protect biodiversity and the marine and coastal ecosystems in which it operates, avoiding or minimizing disturbance from its activities and rehabilitating land or habitats affected by them
- Complete environmental assessments for the aspects and impacts of all new activities the company may undertake, before they commence
- Continually improve its EMS to enhance environmental performance and the prevention of environmental impact, taking into account current best practice, technological advances, current scientific understanding, and customer and community needs, and educate, train and promote employees to work in an environmentally responsible manner
- Promote and encourage the adoption of its environmental principles by suppliers and contractors acting on behalf of the organization
- Develop, implement and maintain emergency preparedness and response plans, including for spills and other environmental incidents
- Foster openness and dialogue with employees and the public, encouraging them to raise concerns or improvement ideas, and set / review measurable environmental objectives and targets through the management review process to ensure the ongoing effectiveness of the EMS.

Any changes for improvement opportunities shall be risk assessed as per the Management of Change process of our Integrated Management System. This Policy shall be communicated within the organization and made available to interested parties upon request.
